2. Each exhibit is allowed only one entry per class.
3. Entry is open to members and residents of Marston Magna or Rimpton only.
4. Entry Forms, fees and exhibits to be handed in at the hall by 10.45 a.m. on the day of the Show. Exhibitors to be clear of the Hall by 11.00 a.m. Points towards the trophies in all section are awarded as follows:
1st - 5 points, 2nd - 3 points, 3rd - 2 points, Highly Commended - 1 point.
6. All trophies shall be held for one year and are awarded as follows:
a. Most points scored in classes 1 - 19

b. Most points scored in classes 20-26
Fruit Cup
c. Best Exhibit in classes 1 to 39
Hayward Hutchings Cup
d. Winner of class 27

Red Lion Cup
g. Most Points scored in classes 41 to 42
Showering Vase
h. Most Points scored in classes 43 to 54
Homcraft Cup
i. Most Points scored in classes 55 to 59
Freeman Cups Boys/Girls
7. Cash prizes for Children's classes only: 1st £4.00, 2nd £2.00 & 3rd £1.00
8. The Judge's decision is final.
9. Exhibitors to provide their own vases etc. for classes 27 to 35.
10. No exhibits shall be removed before the presentation of prizes.
11. Entries class 40 shall only be grown from plants supplied by the Committee.
12. In classes 27 to 38 buds count as blooms.
